It is time to simplify our homes and lives!

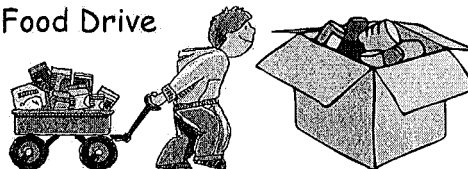

2017-2018 School Ski and Snowboard Club

Dear Parents,

The students at St. Stephen's School will have the exciting opportunity to participate in ski and snowboard club at Holiday Valley this year. Our club will start January 7, 2018 and end March 4, 2018.

Students can arrive at Holiday Valley by 2:30 and will be provided with a one hour ski/snowboard lesson each week, which is included in the cost. The lesson is optional for students who are already proficient and have previous experience. Our club is open to all students in grades K-8, but students in grades K-5 must have a chaperone, that is a parent or guardian. Grades 6-8 will be allowed to attend with only the supervision of myself or another school sanctioned chaperone. However, parents of grades 6-8 students are encouraged to attend, as we would love to have as many participants as possible.

Holiday Valley has offered us a great deal, with the student club pass costing \$163, which includes skiing for EVERY Sunday, the entire season. We are only participating January 7– March 4 as a school club, but the students are free to ski any Sunday from season start to finish with friends and family. Even more exciting is that parents and chaperones are also being offered the student pass price of \$163 for unlimited Sunday skiing. This is only an increase of \$3 from last year's rate.

Unfortunately, transportation is not included. Families are encouraged to carpool and share driving each week. Last year worked out fantastically as many families shared the responsibility of driving and gave many of our students an opportunity attend when rides weren't available from home.

Lastly, ownership of ski or snowboard equipment is **not** required, as students are offered very reasonable prices for rental gear. Most students and chaperones do rent because of the cost of personal gear. The fact that Holiday Valley has Ski and Snowboard gear that is updated every two years and is like NEW makes the experience that much easier.

If you were a member last year and registered for the club online, I encourage you to do the same. Our new members should do the same. If you prefer the paper format, updated sign-up sheets will be placed in the school office at St. Stephens. 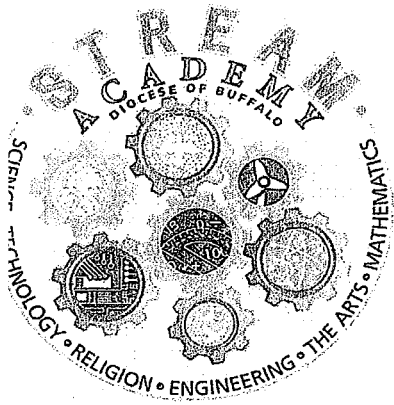
Benefits for students participating in a school ski/snowboard club at Holiday Valley.

Two Options:

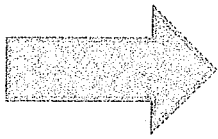
1. Children under 6 are free, but you would be responsible for ski instruction. Rentals would be only cost.
