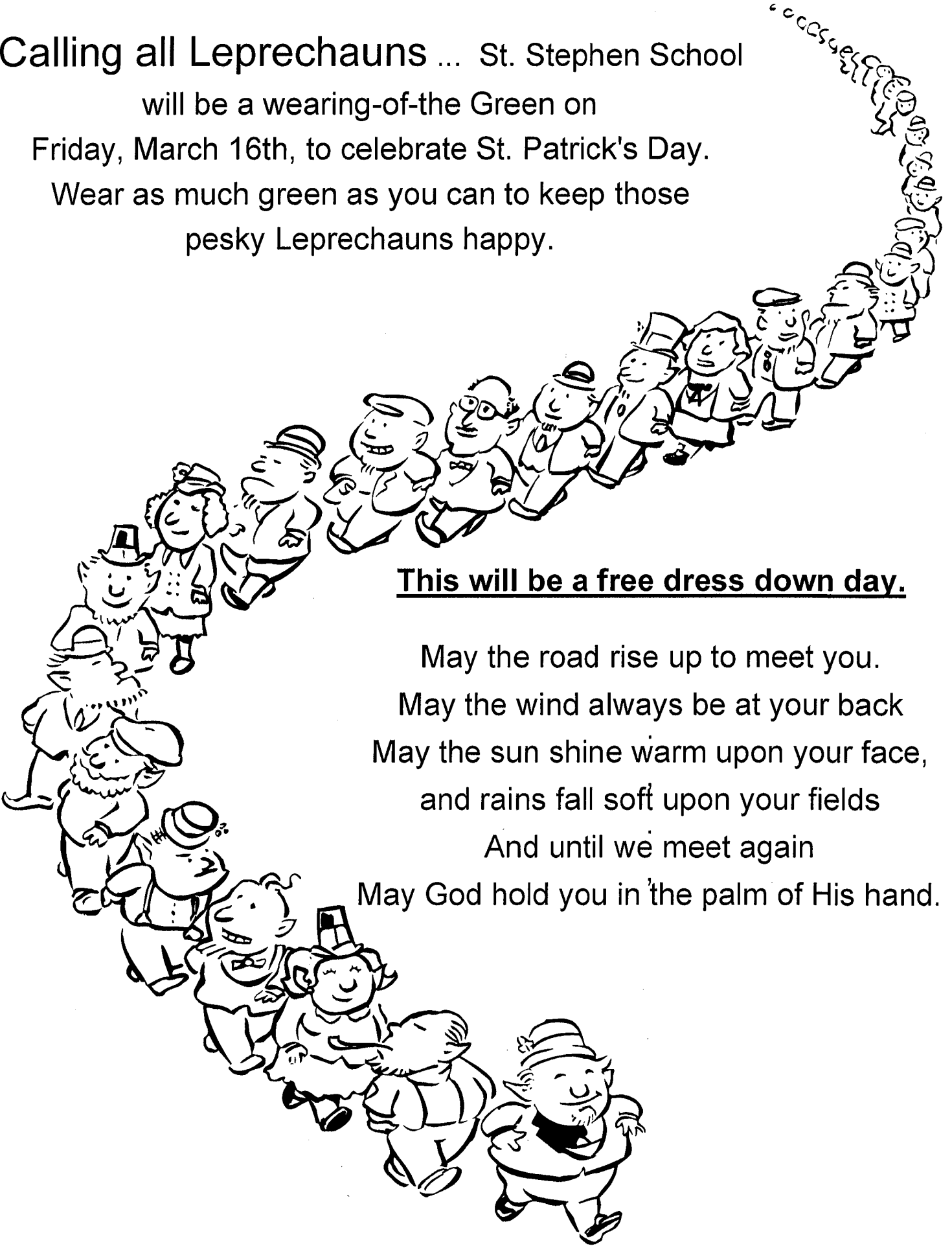

Grades 1/2 are Mites, grades 3/4 are Pee Wee, 5/6 are JV and 7/8 are Varsity.

Soccer uniforms include a shirt, shorts and socks. The shirt and shorts must be returned to the school at the end of the season but players keep the socks, **please do not return them** to the school. There is a \$5 fee for the socks which is included in the registration fee above.

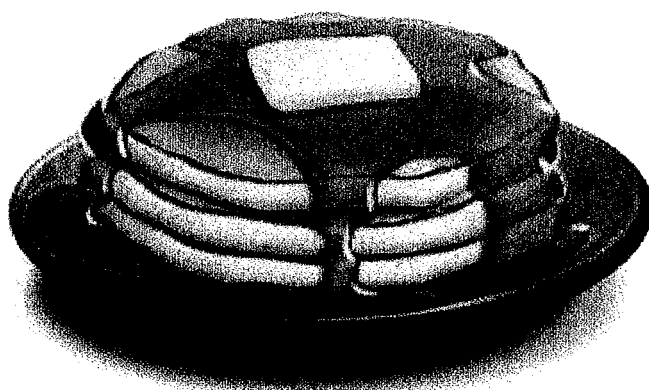
