




If you have not registered for the 2018 - 2019 school year, please do so as soon as possible.

Also, we are always looking for parents to be coaches and/or assistant coaches. Please indicate on the registration form below if you are willing to help with your child's age group. Grades 1/2 are Mites, grades 3/4 are Pee Wee, 5/6 are JV and 7/8 are Varsity.

Soccer uniforms include a shirt, shorts and socks. The shirt and shorts must be returned to the school at the end of the season but players keep the socks, **please do not return them** to the school. There is a \$5 fee for the socks which is included in the registration fee above.

PLEASE NOTE THAT STUDENT ATHLETES MUST HAVE A COMPLETED SPORTS PERMISSION FORM AND MEDICAL RELEASE FORM ON FILE IN THE SCHOOL OFFICE BEFORE THEY CAN START PRACTICE.


