Subject: HERE COMES FISH FRY!!! ... SEEKING TEAM LEADERS

To: St. Stephen School (SSS) Families

Dear Families: -- For the 40th year, we will come together each week for the 7 weeks of Lent to pull off the "**Big Fish**" Fundraiser – big in terms of the size of fish we serve, money raised, and number of volunteers needed! **This year the first SSS Lenten Friday Fish Fry is: February 28, 2020!**

Typically one to three people have shouldered "the lead" for this fundraising event. To make the workload more manageable this year, we are seeking a <u>Team of Task Leaders</u> (dedicated go-getters) to better distribute the effort and organize to get tasks done effectively. We're looking for people we can count on to take ownership of tasks, learn as we go, and do it every week as needed for the duration. We have proven systems and instructions already set up, and experienced past lead volunteers to guide and work together, so there is no-re-creating the wheel (but improvements welcome)!

We are seeking the following Task Leaders:

Position/Lead	Dates required	Description
Placemat Lead	Now thru ~ 2/14	Solicit advertising for placement and Take-Out Menu; Coordinate printing.
Advertising Lead	Now thru ~ 2/14	 Submit press releases/ads to local news publications, church bulletin, school Facebook posting, outdoor sign at church/school.
Procurement Lead (Inventory and Order Supplies)	Pre-Plan Now thru ~ 2/7; and weekly 7pm Friday nights weekly (2/28 – 4/10)	 Pre-season inventory supplies. Pre-season price requests/lock-in from vendors for fish, other food/drink, and supplies. Work with Fish Chairperson on cost vs. dinner price setting. Weekly inventory (Friday night after dinner), Weekly food ordering (Sundays), and bread/minor grocery pickup (Fridays).
Staffing Lead	Begin 1/28 and ongoing/weekly updates	Solicit volunteers (Wednesday email blast) and assign suitable roles; Complete the weekly staff schedule; fill gaps or elevate to fill.
Thursday Set-Up Lead	Weekly Thursdays 2/27 – 4/2	Lead volunteers in Thursday setup tasks (can be afternoon or evening).
Kitchen Lead	Minor pre-planning and weekly Fridays (2/28 4/10)	 Friday afternoon kitchen setup starting 1:30p – end of dinner/7p. Coordinate kitchen volunteers for kitchen prep and serving dinners (facilitate speed, efficiency, and balance between dining room and takeout order fulfillment).
Dining Room Lead	Weekly Fridays (2/28 – 4/10) 3:30 – 7p	 Coordinate volunteers in dining room during dinners (hostesses, wait staff, student busser/coffee volunteers, cashiers, bar tenders, dessert table) – and customer interaction.
Clean Up Lead	Weekly Fridays (2/28 – 4/10) 7p - done	Coordinate volunteers to clean dining room, kitchen, areas used for fish fry event.

Parent-Student Team Leads are also welcome – a good opportunity to work side-by-side with your child to teach/learn Life Skills! And the pay is great...fun, fellowship, and friendship with many others.
