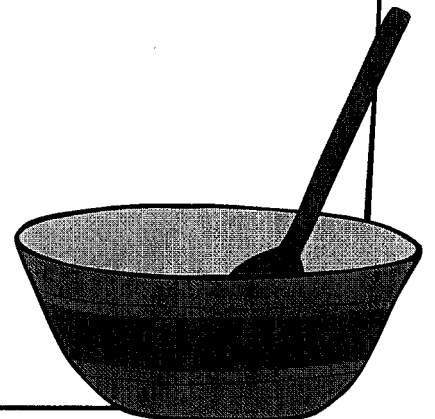
On Friday, January 31st please return one loaf of bread or rolls in the bag provided to school. The bread will be donated to a local nursing home or the Golden Age Center.

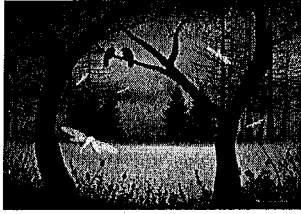

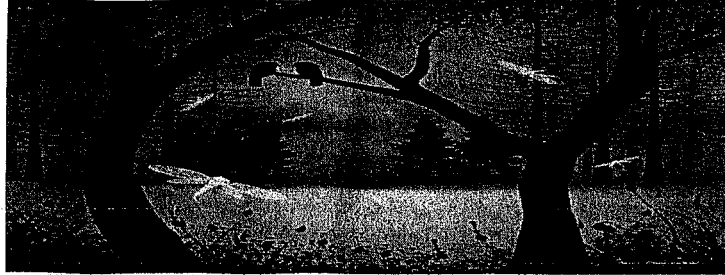

We have proven systems and instructions already set up, and seasoned, experienced volunteers to guide and help -- so there is no-re-creating the wheel!
