On October 31st we will host our annual Trunk or Treat!



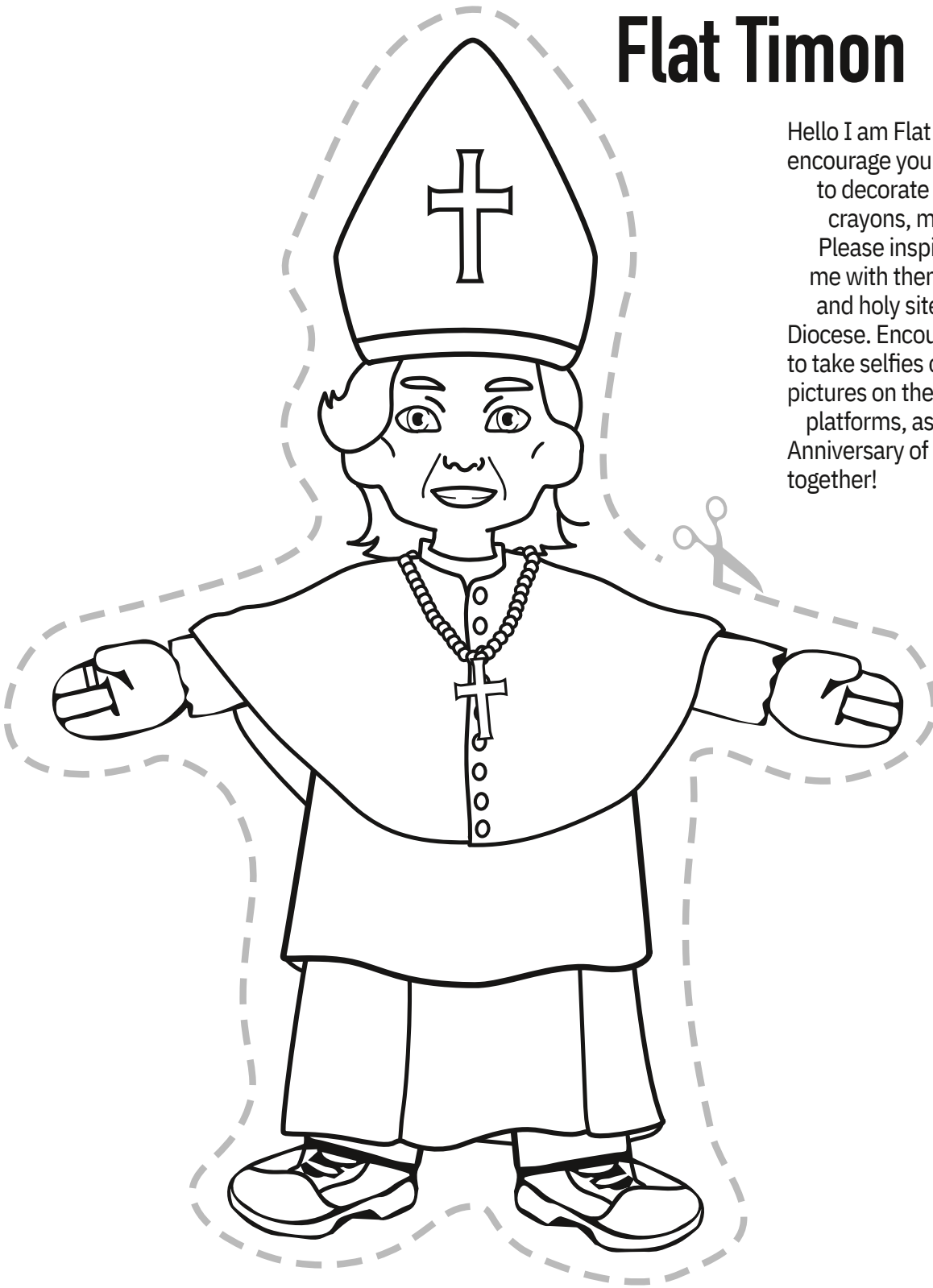
The event will take place in our school parking lot where the children will walk out in shifts with their homeroom class. They will travel from car to car to collect candy.
