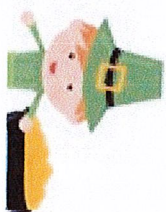

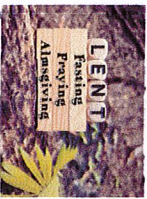

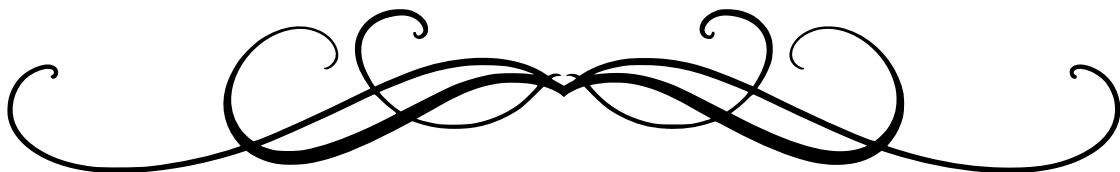
DEAR FAMILIES,

CRS Rice Bowl provides many resources for daily reflection throughout the liturgical season. Consider these suggestions in your family's Lenten plan:

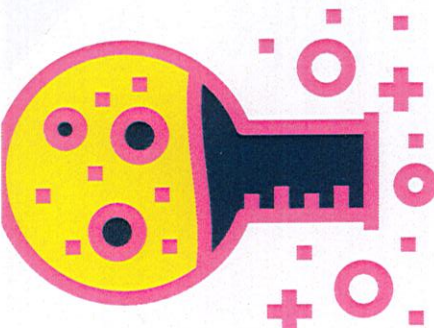
- Use your CRS Rice Bowl and Lenten Calendar each day to guide your prayer, fasting, and almsgiving.

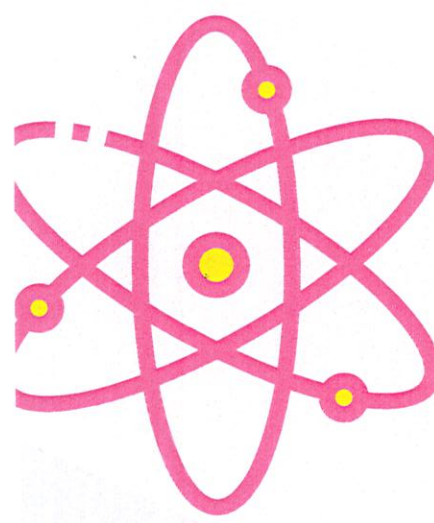

The Diocese of Buffalo Science Fair is an event where science comes alive, thanks to the ideas and research of students!

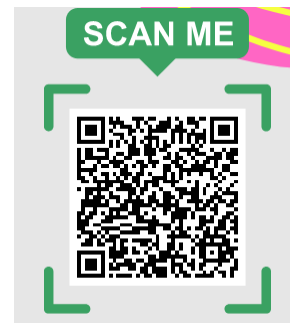
This year's fair will be held on Saturday, March 11th at St. Andrews Country Day School from 8:30 am to 1 pm. This event is open to all students in grades K-8.

- Develop a project (investigation) in an area (Life Science, Physical Science, Earth and Space Science, or Engineering) that he/she chooses and completes a scientific experiment.

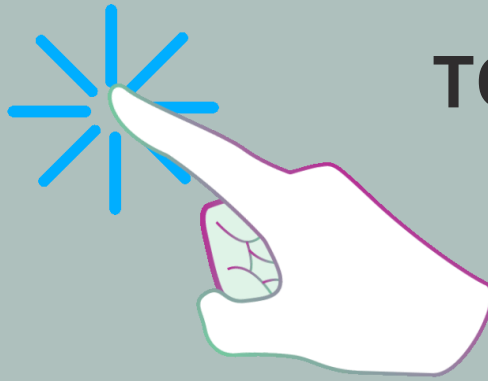
The website www.sciencebuddies.org is a fantastic place to start because you can take a quiz that will find project ideas for your child based on his/her interests.

Tips for a Successful Fundraiser

Use the following steps as a template for success. Successful fundraisers have these same principles in common.

1. Know Your Supporters When inviting people to support you and your cause, let them hear your voice. Since this is shared through links, it's important to make it as personal as possible. It's much more effective to follow up any links shared with a phone call, voice text or even a video.
 - a. It can be very simple: "Hi, this is _____, I'm with _____ (your group) and I'm participating in a fundraiser for _____ (sharing why you're fundraising). Can you help me?" That's it! Good luck! Here's to a successful fundraiser! Supporters usually fall under one of three groups: 1: Family or friends who support you personally
2. People or businesses who support your cause
3. People who like the product or event you're selling Reach out to anyone you can think of that falls under these categories. They'll be happy to help!
4. Know That People Buy from People, Not Link
