

Tips for a Successful Fundraiser

Use the following steps as a template for success. Successful fundraisers have these same principles in common.

1.	Know Your Supporters When inviting people to support you and your cause,
	let them hear your voice. Since this is shared through links, it's important to
	make it as personal as possible. It's much more effective to follow up any
	links shared with a phone call, voice text or even a video.

a.	It can be very simple: "Hi, this is, I'm with (your
	group) and I'm participating in a fundraiser for (sharing why
	you're fundraising). Can you help me?" That's it! Good luck! Here's to a
	successful fundraiser! Supporters usually fall under one of three
	groups: 1: Family or friends who support you personally

- 2. People or businesses who support your cause
- 3. People who like the product or event you're selling Reach out to anyone you can think of that falls under these categories. They'll be happy to help!
- 4. Know That People Buy from People, Not Link
