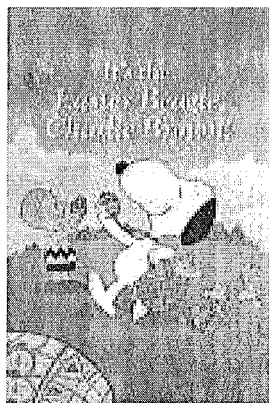

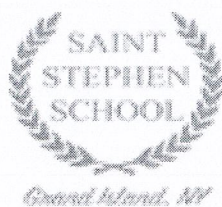

Dear St. Stephen Families,

During the month of April, we will be holding a daily cash calendar fundraiser. For a \$10 donation, participants receive a numbered ticket that is used for the entire month. Each day of April, a random three-digit number will be drawn by an automated random number generator. If the number drawn matches your ticket, in the exact order of the three digits, you win! Pay out for the winning numbers Sunday thru Friday will be \$25/day. Pay out on Saturdays will be \$50. Prizes will be mailed to the name and address associated with each ticket. 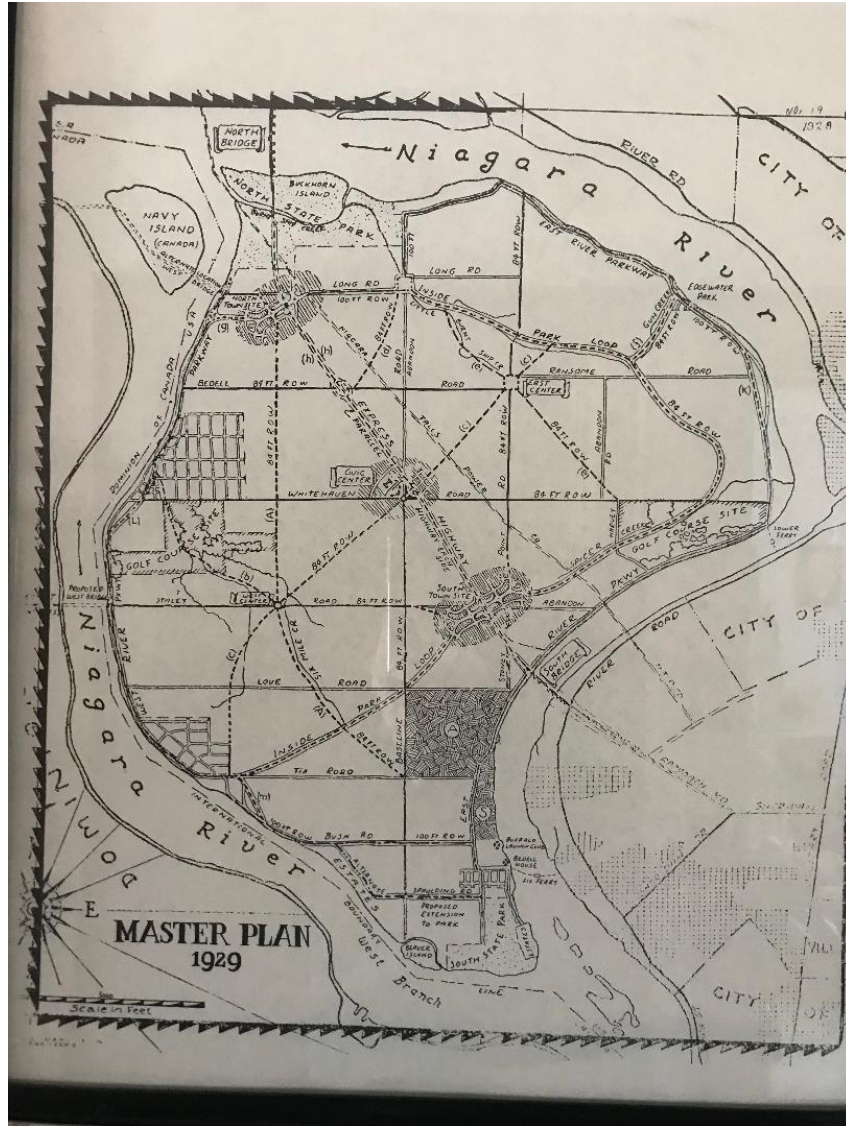

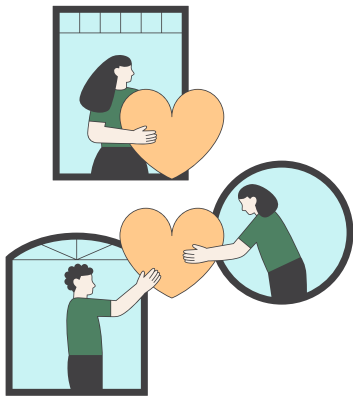
