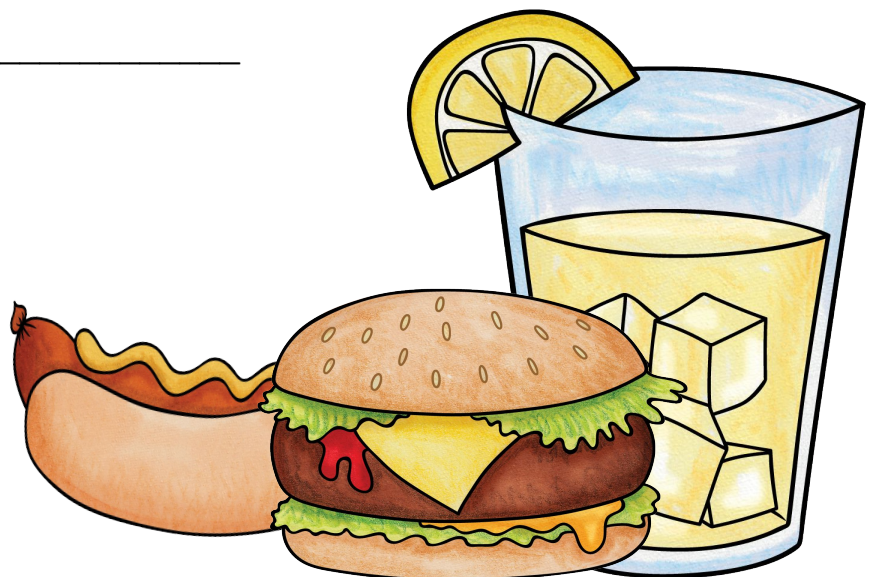

for The New York Times**

What's happening: The New York Times for Kids, which is a section published in the Sunday edition of the New York Times, has asked us to convene a panel of 4-6 middle schoolers to discuss the experience of growing up. We'll be discussing a variety of topics, ranging from the impact of social media to what is particularly exciting, and challenging, about being a tween or young teen today.

Who's involved: The discussion will be moderated by Tim O'Shei, a Mount St. Mary Academy teacher and journalist who is a contributing writer for the New York Times for Kids. He'll be joined by co-moderators including three current MSM students, sophomores Sophia Scime and Juliet Jenkins and senior Laura Pelligra, and an MSM alumna, Emily Matthew, who is currently a senior majoring in communication at the University at Buffalo. Joining the discussion remotely from New York City to listen and take notes will be Lara Sorokanich, a staff editor at the New York Times.

Why are we doing this? The New York Times for Kids is publishing a special edition next month focused on the topic of puberty. The full newspaper section will have a wide range of stories related to that topic – growth, relationships, current events, and so on. Our discussion will focus on questions such as:

- How does social media impact you?
- What's the hardest part of heading into your teen years? What are the good parts?
- What do you wish adults knew or realized about what you're experiencing?

(Our conversation will be focused on the experience of growing up, not the physical changes that come with it.)

Excerpts from the panel discussion will be used in the New York Times for Kids in a few ways: We'll publish quotes from the discussion (and if preferred, you can opt to have your first name and last initial along with your age, rather than your full name). We'll listen to your thoughts and ideas and use those to possibly generate more story topics, too.

Why join us? This is an opportunity to use your voice to connect with thousands of kids and families in the United States and around the world! Your ideas and input will help shape what New York Times readers learn and talk about.

Please note: Space in this session is very limited and may fill before Tuesday morning. Please also reach out with any questions. Thank you!

- The session will be recorded by the New York Times for factual accuracy, but audio and video won't be published.
- Each child's full name and parental contact information will be shared with New York Times editors for fact-checking purposes.

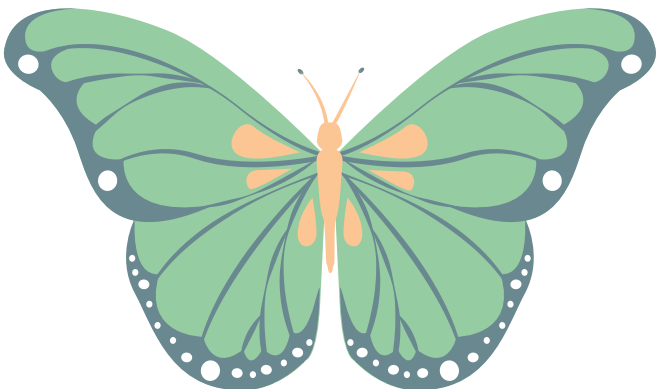
