Again, St. Stephens is offering

Summer Extended Learning Sessions and Sports Classes.

These are 3 hour long sessions that last over the course of one week. Each day there will be separate AM and PM sessions. You will find a schedule for each age group and program descriptions below. The age groups will be Pre-K-Gr. 2, and Gr. 3-8. Students can bring a bagged lunch to eat between sessions if they sign-up for both the AM & PM session.

AM Sessions will run 9:00am-12:00pm.

Lunch will run 12:00-12:30pm.

PM Sessions will run 12:30-3:30pm.

Each session (AM or PM) costs \$150 for the week. If you are signed up for both AM and PM, the cost will be \$300 for the week. Payment is due prior to the first day of the session. Payment goes directly to the teacher. Once registered, each teacher will reach out to participants and give details on payment methods and any specifics to their program.

Some programs have limited availability and you will be notified if you are place on a waitlist.

All programs are subject to cancellation if a minimum number of students is not reached. Parents will be given at least one week notice if a session is to be cancelled.

PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS:

I. PIRATES, PARROTS, AND BURIED TREASURE
